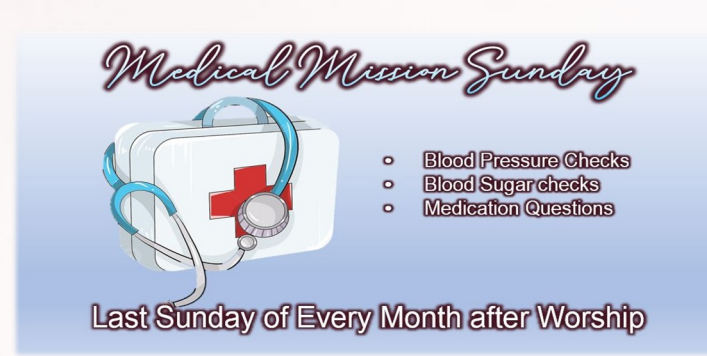
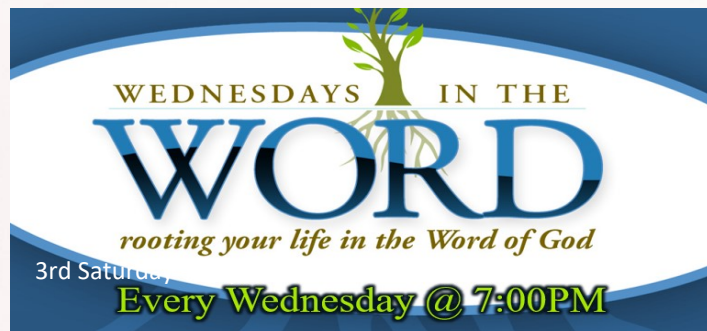
This example for us was in Your being poured out on a cross, on a hill called Calvary-Golgotha: a place whose meaning is 'the place of the skull' a place of sin and death.
