Praying Against the Spiritual Evil For the Children of Our Communities

Heavenly Father,

You have given us an opportunity, the question is: What will we do with it? Will we pick up our cross and suffer for Christ; who himself suffered for us or will we say 'it's too hard' as the young do who have yet to learn that yes, some things are hard, some things taste bitter, and some things are worth suffering for!

We must learn as parents, as family members, friends and community – that when it is a child, that there can be none- that we are not willing to suffer for. Only then can we realize the full weight of what you suffered for us, and that there is no suffering too great!

This example for us was in Your being poured out on a cross, on a hill called Calvary-Golgotha: a place whose meaning is 'the place of the skull' a place of sin and death.

When we think of the children, we must consider which hill we will choose to die on: one that brings life or one that brings comfort, pleasure, and wealth? We must consider the cost that either we or our children will have to pay.

<u>Deut. 30:19 "Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live!</u>

Lord of heaven and earth, of all that is righteous and good and holy; forgive us for not standing when we could, not speaking when we should, and for our lack of willingness to die for one another: especially, the children amongst us.

Lord, help us to choose wisely; to choose life. Amen


