

~ Prayers for the People ~

Dear Lord Jesus, we come before You today in awe of Your glory. You are our Savior and Lord. Because of Your obedience to the Father of Heaven and Earth, You suffered and died for our sins. God raised You from the dead and gave You all authority in heaven and on earth (Matthew 28:18) and yet You want to be our friend. (John 15:13-14) "Greater love has no one then this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if You do what I command."

"A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity" (Proverbs 17:17) and "one who has unreliable friends soon comes to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother" (Proverbs 18:24). These Old Testament writings in Your Word are proof of the value You place on friendship. We can understand this because of our own life stories, but why would an awesome God like You, Jesus, want our friendship? Also, Romans 8:15 & 16 says "The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by Him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are children, then we are heirs – heir of God and co-heirs with Christ. So, we are also brothers! Brothers and friends.

This is hard for us to understand because You, Lord, are so mighty, glorious and powerful. Lord Jeus, we ask that You increase our faith to believe this.
