Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any power, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:35-39

Because of that open realization: there are few who are <u>truly committed</u> to the raising up the children in the shadow of the Lord.

The pleasures, comforts and conformation that is demanded of by the secular world today, is scooping up our children and dashing them against the rocks; leaving them broken in so many ways!

How quickly they have been taught to lovingly hate in the name of equity and equality.

You say in your word that vengeance is yours, that vindication for evils done will come through you, and we believe that your word stands true, yet the concern grows for the future generations-our children's children and their children's children: for without your interceding today-they will be so far from you!

Father, remember them- each of them, Father call them out of the darkness, Father call for them to come out of the world and then show them the wonders of your love.

Lord, deliver them-from evil. In Jesus name Amen


