May the light of Christ penetrate and break up these celebrations of death, putting to silence: a great lie and revealing an even greater deception!

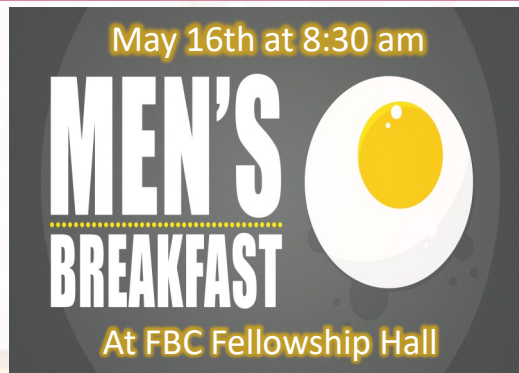
